TRAINING COURSE ON HOW TO USE PERCUSSION TO WORK WITH YOUNG PEOPLE AT RISK

Description:

Percussive Society project is a youth initiative of the musician François Archanjo, which developed many concepts in the educational and social areas for already 10 years.

The project raised on the needs of the improvement of personal rhythms and expressions of people using examples of the daily life, mixing sounds from drums, recycled and re-used materials.

This project follows the path of the musician, who already performs lectures and workshops of percussion in Brazil and abroad. The discovery of new sounds and expressions are the main aim, where the participants have the possibility to express themselves.

The project improves the music expression of the participants, bringing an exciting discover of different Brazilian and African rhythms and values.

Aim:

Trumm-It! is a training course that aims to support the professional development of youth workers and leaders to use percussion as a tool to improve youth participation with young people at risk of exclusion.

Objectives

- pointing out the connection between citizenship, responsibility for one's immediate environment and society and active participation through music
- experiencing, discussing and sharing historical and recent understandings of inclusion and its implications for participation concerning young people in disadvantage neighbourhoods
- approaching different methods and tools to use different percussion for youth work
- sharing different visions and understandings of inclusion of young people at risk;
- experiencing percussive music in praxis by simulations, cases and method development aiming young people;

Target group:

- youth trainers/workers
- youth trainers/workers who are actively working with young people as a professional or on the voluntary basis
- participants that have an active attitude!

aged 18 - ? (preferably up to 30)

Time plan and venue:

Submission: 30th April 2015, submission of the application under Erasmus + programme

Date of the training: **September/October 2015**

Venue: Lahmuse Manor in Suure-Jaani parish (<http://www.lahmuse.edu.ee/kuelaliste.html>)

Group and duration:

All Erasmus Plus - *programme countries* (EU Members + EFTA Countries/Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein and Switzerland/ + Candidate countries /Turkey and Croatia) are eligible to apply.

We aim at youth organizations from at least 12 countries represented by at least 2 participants each.

Duration (without travel days) will be **7 working days**.

Financial aspects

Accommodation and lodging covered by 100% by the Erasmus +

Travel expenses partially covered by Erasmus + (the amount depends of the route to the venue of the training)

Participation Fee: **25 euros**
